### Assembly Plan

1. Summer fun	2 mins	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Introduce the assembly by highlighting that summer is on its way, which means lots of free time to have fun.</li> <li>○ Go through the slides, highlighting the exciting things that people enjoy in the summer: eating, holidays and sports.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Warm up activity to get pupils thinking about the holidays.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Slides 1-6</li> </ul>
2. World Cup mania	1 mins	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Acknowledge that this year is a special year for sport. Can any pupils identify what sporting event is taking place (or has taken place)?</li> <li>○ Highlight that the World Cup is the most widely viewed sporting event in the world.</li> <li>○ Explain that football is a national sport in many countries, including England, Brazil, Scotland etc. Explain that a national sport is a sport or game that is considered to be an intrinsic part of a countries culture.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Awareness of the World Cup.</li> <li>○ Awareness that football is a national sport in England.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Slides 7-8</li> </ul>
3. Global variety	3 mins	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Present slides 9-13 which show different sports. Ask pupils to raise their hands and identify in which country it is a national sport.</li> <li>● Highlight that there is a huge and exciting range of sports around the world to try, and today many of them are available for us to play in the UK.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Awareness of global national sports.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Slides 9-14</li> </ul>

Sporting Chance	3 mins	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Explain that Sporting Chance is a way of trying different sports in their local area during the summer holidays.</li> <li>○ Explain that ASDA has teamed up with lots of local sports clubs to provide free sports sessions for everyone that wants to take part.</li> <li>○ Use Slides 15-21 to explain how to get involved with Sporting Chance. If your school has taken part in Sporting Chance before then these should act as a reminder.</li> <li>○ All pupils need to do to get involved is: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Collect a voucher: from the school, online or from any ASDA store.</li> <li>○ Find out what's on offer: pupils simply visit the website (<a href="http://www.ASDA.com/freeactivities">www.ASDA.com/freeactivities</a>) to find out what's available in their area.</li> <li>○ Book a place: Phone the provider for the experience you want to take part in and book a place.</li> <li>○ Turn up and take part!</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Understand the Sporting chance scheme, the opportunity it represents and how to take part.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Slides 15-21</li> </ul>
