

Assembly Plan Delivery Notes

Overview:

This assembly plan encourages pupils to think about the wide variety of sports and its many benefits. Sporting Chance is introduced as a way of accessing and trying sport for free. The assembly is designed to be fun and interactive.

You could invite an ASDA Events Coordinator to attend the assembly. They could run the assembly independently or act as an assistant, supporting specific areas, such as pupils' questions. If you do invite them, you should discuss how you will run the assembly in advance.

Learning objectives:

- Know that there are a wide variety of sports.
- Understand that sport has many benefits and can be played in a variety of places outside of school.
- Know that Sporting Chance is a scheme that offers free sports in the holidays.
- Understand how to take part in Sporting Chance.

Preparation notes:

- Before delivering the assembly you should run through the presentation in Slide Show so you are familiar with the animations that appear as you click your mouse.
- Episode 2 offers a variety of delivery ideas so you will need to decide on the method in advance and prepare any equipment or support from other members of staff.
- You should have copies of the Parents Letter and Get Active appointment cards to show pupils and should explain how they will be distributed e.g. in class, after the assembly or sent home.
- You will need to find out what sports are on offer in your local area. You should add this information to Slide 10. Search for providers online: www.asda.com/freeactivities

1. Many sports	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ask pupils to raise their arms to volunteer their favourite sports. After asking a few, click Slide 2 to conclude that there are a huge variety of different and fun sports for everyone to try! 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identify a wide variety of sports. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Slide 2
2. What sport am I?	3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Now explain that you will test their sports knowledge! There are different delivery options: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Role play- pupils try to identify the sport which you act out - perhaps with colleagues or the ASDA Events Coordinator. Some can be quite easy such as football, some more obscure such as fencing or capoeira. You could concentrate on sports which reflect those on offer in your area. Present equipment - present actual sport equipment and ask pupils to identify which sport it is used in. Slide reveal - click the slides to reveal two images of equipment before revealing the name of each sport. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Improve pupils' knowledge of different sports. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sports equipment Slides 3-6
3. Many benefits	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Highlight that sport has many benefits. Click to reveal the benefits on Slide 7. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Understand the benefits of sport. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Slide 7
4. Many places	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explain that pupils can take part in sport in many places - not just in school. Click to reveal the different places on Slide 8. Highlight that sports clubs offer a good opportunity which leads into the introduction of Sporting Chance. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identify different places for taking part in sports outside school. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Slide 8
5. Sporting Chance	3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduce the Sporting Chance scheme and explain that this will help them to do more sport outside of school and also introduces them to local clubs. Explain: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> what the Sporting Chance program is that it is free how they take part. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Understand the Sporting Chance scheme and how to take part. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Slides 9-15
6. Any questions?	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Answer any questions from the pupils. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reinforce understanding. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Slide 16
